The Gala on Saturday night honored Mr. Jimmy Pitaro of ESPN along with our recipient who received the National Special Achievement Award. Also, the Dr. Anthony P. Vastola Award was awarded to our UNICO National Chaplin, Rev. Robert Wolfee.

Please try to attend our September 14th membership meeting at Amore Restaurant to meet our special guest "Gabriella Socio", from M.S.U. She received our Italian Study Abroad Grant. Please save this date to welcome her.

We also started distributing our wine raffle tickets, with a drawing on December 7^{th} , where the proceeds will benefit our chapter causes.

On a final note, there was a Thank You in the Holy Cross Church Bulletin thanking everyone (and we were a part of it) who donated to the Ukrainian cause. The total donations to the UACCNJ included 18 shipping containers: 14 by sea and 4 by air, 3 ambulances, 11 Wound Vacs, 15 Pickup Trucks, 1,500,000 packaged meals, 100,000 Pampers, 3,000 First Aid Kits, 200 fully stocked medic backpacks, and 12 weekly critical medical supply shipments by air. In all, \$4,000,00 in aid which weighed more than 700,000 lbs.



UNICO was founded on October 10, 1922, in Waterbury, Connecticut. A group of 15 men, led by Dr. Anthony P. Vastola, came together to create what has become a very special and very proud organization. It was Dr. Vastola's dream to create an Italian American service organization to engage in charitable works, support higher education, and perform patriotic deeds. Our motto is *"Service Above Self"*.

Each year, the UNICO Foundation and the UNICO National Chapters across the country donate approximately \$1 million to various charities. Scholarships continue to be the primary focus of UNICO, as roughly one-third of all monies raised goes to deserving students from all the chapter locations throughout the chain.

UNICO National has funded major research in Cooley's Anemia and Mental Health. Through its association with the Jimmy Valvano Foundation, it has funded over 10, \$50,000 grants to help find a cure for Cancer. These worthy areas continue to receive generous support from the chapters and its members for these worthy causes.
