

Our Italian Heritage



This photo appears in the 2022 UNICO National Heritage & Photo Calendar in the month of May It was taken in in Seradifalco, Caltanasetta, Sicily by a UNICO National member ~~~ Anthony Pelonero, Midlothian, VA

Anthony and his brother Steven and Sal Benvenuti, and their wives of course, were all there in 2020 They were able to get to this town where the Pelonero heritage was started 4 generations ago

- Seradifalco was the site of the first bicycle manufacturer in southern Italy, Montante Cicli, which produces one of the world's elite brands of bicycles
- Sulfur mining, in some of the oldest mines in Sicily, and farming, were the most prevalent occupations in Seradifalco after the Italian unification in 1860
- Seradifalco was the site of the first bicycle manufacturer in southern Italy, Montante Cicli, which produces one of the world's elite brands of bicycles
- In the great emigration of Sicilians to the United States in the late 19th and early 20th centuries, many Seradifalchesi farm laborers and sulfur miners went to American towns, including Pittston and Robertsdale, where they worked as coal miners; and to Buffalo and its rural environs, where they found employment with the steel plants and railroads, and in the strawberry and corn fields
